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Exhibit 32: State Laws and Regulations

This Exhibit will track the requirements of proposed Stipulation 32, dated August 20, 2019, and therefore, the requirements of 16 NYCRR § 1001.32.

32(a) State Approvals, Consents, Permits, Certificates, or Other Conditions of a Procedural Nature

The Applicant has compiled a list of state approvals, consents, permits, certificates, or other conditions of a procedural nature that are applicable to the construction or operation of the Project (see Table 32-1 below). These state requirements are supplanted by PSL Article 10 unless the Board expressly authorizes the exercise of such authority by the state agency.

At this time, the Applicant anticipates that the NYSDOT Highway Work Permits will be issued by NYSDOT and not be issued by the Department of Public Service Staff. The Applicant hereby requests that the Board authorize NYSDOT to exercise their authority to issue all required approvals.
